MISSOURI VOTERS:
Know your options!

- Absentee in Person**
Starts Sept. 22. No application in advance or notary is necessary but must give a reason at the time you vote.
- Absentee by Mail**
Must apply by email, fax, mail or in-person. Health-based reasons do not require a notary on ballot envelope but others will. Can be returned IN PERSON to Election Board/Clerk's Office.
- In Person on Election Day**
Polling places may have changed--know before you go!
- No-Excuse Mail-In Ballot**
Must apply by mail or in person. Ballot envelope must be notarized and can only be returned by US Mail.
